



Focus Day: Basic FBA/BIP 2-Day Training

MIBLSI is proud to offer a 2-day Basic FBA/BIP Training. At this training, participants will focus on the use of the Functional Assessment Checklist for Teachers and Students (FACTS) in conjunction with the ABC observation to develop a summary or hypothesis statement.

This session is designed for specific personnel identified to facilitate the FBA-BIP development process, coaches, and problem-solving teams:

- Potential FBA-BIP facilitators: (i.e. counselors, social workers, school psychologists, behavior specialists, special education personnel, community partners, etc.)
- District/building based coaches specifically focused on supporting Tier 2 and/or Tier 3 interventions
- Problem Solving Team members: individuals who will help in the development of behavior intervention plans. (administrators, teachers, paraprofessionals, one-on-one aides)
