- **Instructional Literacy Coaching Network:** In order to increase student literacy outcomes as indicated in the Michigan 3rd grade Reading Law PA 306, a coaching network will be offered through Ingham ISD. The purpose of developing a coaching network series is to increase Ingham's capacity to improve children's literacy learning by enhancing best practices in the classroom. Coaches will work through a research based cycle of adult learning with teachers in their classrooms. Coaches will meet with teachers on multiple occasions implementing evidence

based instructional strategies as referenced in John Hattie, Anita Archer and the Essential Literacy Practices in Early Literacy and Coaching Essentials.

Mark Benvenuto (UDMercy) and Larry Kolopajlo (EMU) are coediting a book dedicated to green chemistry education, and invite high school teachers to contribute a chapter. Volume 1 titled Sustainable Green Chemistry (DeGruyter, ISBN 978-3-11-044189-5) has just been published. Volume 2 is in the final stages of proof, and we are lining up authors for volume 3 that will focus on Green Chemistry Education. A formal call generally goes out in June, and a final chapter is due in early December. Possible subject matter could involve creating a new course on green chemistry, training students, or integrating green chemistry into existing courses. Other ideas include: outreach, training teachers or industrial workers, case studies, new laboratory experiments, replacement labs, introducing industrial applications of green chemistry to students or teachers, or alternative energy.
