Social Studies – Tara Becker-Utess

- **Updated Standards Update (from MDE Social Studies Consultant):** We have two focus group subcommittee meetings. One on World History and Geography (MS and HS) and one on US History and Geography (MS and HS). Hoping for agreements on those areas. K-5 is in good shape, Civics and Econ are in good shape. Whole focus group on October 10th for consensus on entire document. Present to board Nov or Dec. Implementation can't be nailed down yet, it will depend on the assessment.
- **Electoral College Prediction Contest through the Michigan Council of History Education.** Teachers are encouraged to have their students study the Electoral College system, researching the possible winning political party in all fifty states and the District of Columbia. Using the student research teachers will then collate the student analysis and submit a Contest Entry form, available at www.michiganhistoryed.org
- **The MI Open Book Project** has completed another round of online textbooks for social studies. <http://textbooks.wmisd.org/> now has third through 8th grade as well as economics, civics, and US history.
