## District Leadership Year Long Focus:

Effective district/school leaders must leverage their high impact leadership practices. Skilled leadership is needed to help teachers and school leaders link their account of their own teaching and leading (e.g., practices being implemented, sources being used, activities planned, etc.) to its actual impact on all student learning.

This professional learning and associated materials will be aligned to Marzano, Danielson and 5D evaluation framework and will include customized Visible Learning crosswalks as part of the ongoing training, and implementation support. Connecting the 'everyday' practices supported through Leverage Leadership (Kim Marshall) to the high yield strategies to make an impact.

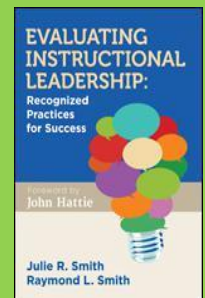
