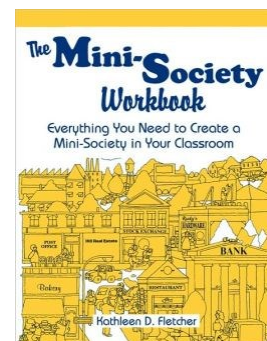




# Mini Society: Economics Comes Alive!
