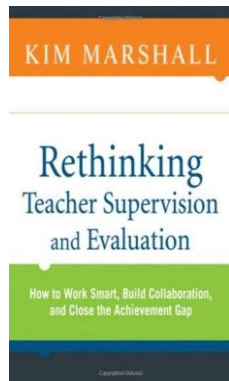


LEVERAGE LEADERSHIP 2.0: THE NEXT STEPS FOR LEADERS
